





THIS ADDENDUM NO. 1 relates to the above-referenced **VALLEY BOULEVARD AT SANTA ANITA DEMOLITION PROJECT** (hereinafter, the "Project") which will be undertaken by the City of El Monte. This Addendum No. 1 shall be considered part of the bid documents, and provides the following revisions:

1. **APPENDIX 1 (Asbestos-Containing Materials Survey) Page 4 of 7:** The summary of locations and quantities of ACMS for 10611 Valley Mall is revised as follows:

- SAM: Total removal (2,400 square feet [sq ft])
- VFT mastic: Total removal (2,400 sq ft)
- Roofing mastic: Roof area – patches/penetrations (50 sq ft)
- Transite pipes: Roof area (10 linear feet [ln ft]/4-in diameter)
(10 ln ft/6-in diameter)

2. **SECTION 13280 (Asbestos Abatement):** Add the following to Article 1.06 Notifications and Permits:

Contractor shall complete all required notifications and obtain all permits relating to asbestos abatement within 15 working days following issuance of the Notice to Proceed. This includes the SCAQMD 10-day waiting period.

3. **SECTION 02300 (Earthwork) Page 2:** Delete *PART 3 – EXECUTION* and replace with the following:

PART 3 - EXECUTION

1. EXCAVATION AND SUB-GRADE PREPARATION

- A. All work shall be done in conformance the requirements of SSPWC Section 300,

unless otherwise noted.

- B. Contractor shall conduct construction surveys to establish elevations of sub-grade prior to beginning soil scarifying operations.
- C. All fill and backfill operations to raise soil elevations or to fill void spaces up to top of sub-grade shall be evenly distributed and compacted to a relative compaction of 90 percent. All existing concrete footings and building apparatus below ground surface shall be removed and replaced with compacted fill, unless otherwise noted.
- D. Contractor shall remove wet sub base material, if any and replace it with suitable dry material as directed by Engineer. The cost for removal and disposing wet sub base materials, and replacing and re-compacting with suitable material shall be paid by the Awarding Agency as an extra. Contractor shall be responsible for paying for all costs for such work and material if such high moisture content of wet material is the result of any action by Contractor on the part of construction, or inaction by Contractor in protecting the work during the course of the contract as outlined in the Part 2 of Section 02300.

PREBID QUESTIONS

Q1: **Who does the contractor contact in order to take down the VPS security boards/equipment currently securing the building structures? Does it need to be saved/not damaged?**

A1: The equipment is rented from VPS and shall not be damaged by the Contractor. The Contractor shall contact VPS and schedule the removal of the security equipment. The equipment shall not be removed until the property and buildings are secured by the Contractor and the Contractor is prepared to assume full responsibility for securing the site. Q2: **Will the onsite concrete walkways, sidewalks, and other surrounding concrete flatwork need to be removed and replaced with Asphalt-Concrete (A.C.)?**

A2: All concrete walkways and curbs immediately adjacent to the buildings, excluding sidewalks on public rights of way, shall be removed as part of the demolition of the buildings. This also includes the concrete slab adjacent to the roll-up doors at 10611 Valley Mall. The planters shall be protected in place. All voids remaining from the removal of the buildings and associated walkways/slabs shall be replaced with 3 inches of Asphalt pavement on 6 inches of Crushed Miscellaneous Base material per **Section 02510 – Asphalt Pavement** of the Specifications.

Q3: **Provide information pertaining to the Hydraulic lifts in the former tire shop (10611 Valley Mall).**

A3: In May 2010, SCS conducted a Phase II Site Investigation that consisted of collecting soil and soil vapor samples from the Property. Total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH) were not detected in the analyzed soil samples. Benzene and tetrachloroethene (PCE) were both detected in some

soil vapor samples collected at a depth of 5 feet below ground surface (bgs) (Figure 3. Table 1), attached to this Addendum No. 1. Based on the results of this investigation, SCS concluded the following:

Benzene was detected in only one soil vapor sample, at the detection limit of 0.10 µg/L, which exceeds the residential but not the commercial/industrial California Human Health Screening Levels (CHHSLs). Depending on the future site use, further evaluation of benzene beneath the Property may be necessary, but at this time the limited detection of benzene (1 sample) is not considered to be of concern.

PCE was detected in eight vapor samples from various locations on the Property at concentrations equal to or exceeding the residential but not the commercial/industrial CHHSL. The highest concentrations of PCE are located within the auto service facility; however, the PCE may have originated from an off-site source.

Due to the low concentration levels detected, no special disposal/handling requirements are anticipated for the soil located at the project site as it related to the hydraulic lifts.

Q4: Is compaction testing required?

A4: Compaction testing is required. The City will provide all compaction testing by an independent testing firm at no cost to the Contractor.

Q5: Is there lead paint in the buildings.

A5: Testing for lead paint was not completed by the City. Contractors involved in renovation/demolition activities must adhere to lead-in-construction work practices regardless of lead concentrations (i.e., worker respiratory protection). In addition, guidance issued by the United States Environmental Protection Agency in July 2000 allows contractors to dispose of demolition debris containing lead-based paint as household waste. Therefore, there are no restrictions that apply to the disposal of debris resulting from the demolition of these structures. However, care should be taken to prevent dispersion of lead-based paint during building demolition (i.e., minimize fugitive dust emissions as it applies to normal demolition activities).

Q6: Is a 10 day Asbestos Notification required?

A6: Any ACM abatement contractor is aware that any large scale asbestos removal project (e.g., 100 square feet of ACM or greater) requires that SCAQMD must be notified spawning a ten working day waiting period after which abatement activities can begin [refer to SCAQMD Rule 1403(d)(B)(i)].



- Q7: For the upcoming demolition project of 3 buildings, will the City require the lowest responsible bidder (contractor) to pay the diversion deposit or administrative fee? Is there a requirement to achieve 50% diversion of the waste onsite?
- A7: The requirements for waste diversion for the project are per **Section 01800 – Construction and Demolition Debris Recycling** of the Specifications. The City will not require the Contractor to provide a Diversion Deposit. However, the required ten (10) percent payment retention will not be released by the City and paid to the Contractor until the Contractor has complied with all requirements of Section 01800. In addition, the City will waive the Administrative Fee, Franchise Fee and AB393 Fee for this project.

THIS ADDENDUM NO. 1 relates to the above-referenced **VALLEY BOULEVARD AT SANTA ANITA DEMOLITION PROJECT** (hereinafter, the "Project") which will be undertaken by the City of El Monte. This Addendum No. 1 shall be considered part of the bid documents, and provides the following revisions:

1. **APPENDIX 1 (Asbestos-Containing Materials Survey) Page 4 of 7:** The summary of locations and quantities of ACMS for 10611 Valley Mall is revised as follows:

- SAM: Total removal (2,400 square feet [sq ft])
- VFT mastic: Total removal (2,400 sq ft)
- Roofing mastic: Roof area – patches/penetrations (50 sq ft)
- Transite pipes: Roof area (10 linear feet [ln ft]/4-in diameter)
(10 ln ft/6-in diameter)

2. **SECTION 13280 (Asbestos Abatement):** Add the following to Article 1.06 Notifications and Permits:

Contractor shall complete all required notifications and obtain all permits relating to asbestos abatement within 15 working days following issuance of the Notice to Proceed. This includes the SCAQMD 10-day waiting period.

3. **SECTION 02300 (Earthwork) Page 2:** Delete *PART 3 – EXECUTION* and replace with the following:

PART 3 - EXECUTION

1. EXCAVATION AND SUB-GRADE PREPARATION

A. All work shall be done in conformance the requirements of SSPWC Section 300,

unless otherwise noted.

- B. Contractor shall conduct construction surveys to establish elevations of sub-grade prior to beginning soil scarifying operations.
- C. All fill and backfill operations to raise soil elevations or to fill void spaces up to top of sub-grade shall be evenly distributed and compacted to a relative compaction of 90 percent. All existing concrete footings and building apparatus below ground surface shall be removed and replaced with compacted fill, unless otherwise noted.
- D. Contractor shall remove wet sub base material, if any and replace it with suitable dry material as directed by Engineer. The cost for removal and disposing wet sub base materials, and replacing and re-compacting with suitable material shall be paid by the Awarding Agency as an extra. Contractor shall be responsible for paying for all costs for such work and material if such high moisture content of wet material is the result of any action by Contractor on the part of construction, or inaction by Contractor in protecting the work during the course of the contract as outlined in the Part 2 of Section 02300.

Q1: **Who does the contractor contact in order to take down the VPS security boards/equipment currently securing the building structures? Does it need to be saved/not damaged?**

A1: The equipment is rented from VPS and shall not be damaged by the Contractor. The Contractor shall contact VPS and schedule the removal of the security equipment. The equipment shall not be removed until the property and buildings are secured by the Contractor and the Contractor is prepared to assume full responsibility for securing the site. Q2: **Will the onsite concrete walkways, sidewalks, and other surrounding concrete flatwork need to be removed and replaced with Asphalt-Concrete (A.C.)?**

A2: All concrete walkways and curbs immediately adjacent to the buildings, excluding sidewalks on public rights of way, shall be removed as part of the demolition of the buildings. This also includes the concrete slab adjacent to the roll-up doors at 10611 Valley Mall. The planters shall be protected in place. All voids remaining from the removal of the buildings and associated walkways/slabs shall be replaced with 3 inches of Asphalt pavement on 6 inches of Crushed Miscellaneous Base material per **Section 02510 – Asphalt Pavement** of the Specifications.

Q3: **Provide information pertaining to the Hydraulic lifts in the former tire shop (10611 Valley Mall).**

A3: In May 2010, SCS conducted a Phase II Site Investigation that consisted of collecting soil and soil vapor samples from the Property. Total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH) were not detected in the analyzed soil samples. Benzene and tetrachloroethene (PCE) were both detected in some

soil vapor samples collected at a depth of 5 feet below ground surface (bgs) (Figure 3, Table 1), attached to this Addendum No. 1. Based on the results of this investigation, SCS concluded the following:

Benzene was detected in only one soil vapor sample, at the detection limit of 0.10 µg/L, which exceeds the residential but not the commercial/industrial California Human Health Screening Levels (CHHSLs). Depending on the future site use, further evaluation of benzene beneath the Property may be necessary, but at this time the limited detection of benzene (1 sample) is not considered to be of concern.

PCE was detected in eight vapor samples from various locations on the Property at concentrations equal to or exceeding the residential but not the commercial/industrial CHHSL. The highest concentrations of PCE are located within the auto service facility; however, the PCE may have originated from an off-site source.

Due to the low concentration levels detected, no special disposal/handling requirements are anticipated for the soil located at the project site as it related to the hydraulic lifts.

Q4: Is compaction testing required?

A4: Compaction testing is required. The City will provide all compaction testing by an independent testing firm at no cost to the Contractor.

Q5: Is there lead paint in the buildings.

A5: Testing for lead paint was not completed by the City. Contractors involved in renovation/demolition activities must adhere to lead-in-construction work practices regardless of lead concentrations (i.e., worker respiratory protection). In addition, guidance issued by the United States Environmental Protection Agency in July 2000 allows contractors to dispose of demolition debris containing lead-based paint as household waste. Therefore, there are no restrictions that apply to the disposal of debris resulting from the demolition of these structures. However, care should be taken to prevent dispersion of lead-based paint during building demolition (i.e., minimize fugitive dust emissions as it applies to normal demolition activities).

Q6: Is a 10 day Asbestos Notification required?

A6: Any ACM abatement contractor is aware that any large scale asbestos removal project (e.g., 100 square feet of ACM or greater) requires that SCAQMD must be notified spawning a ten working day waiting period after which abatement activities can begin [refer to SCAQMD Rule 1403(d)(B)(i)].



- A7: The requirements for waste diversion for the project are per **Section 01800 – Construction and Demolition Debris Recycling** of the Specifications. The City will not require the Contractor to provide a Diversion Deposit. However, the required ten (10) percent payment retention will not be released by the City and paid to the Contractor until the Contractor has complied with all requirements of Section 01800. In addition, the City will waive the Administrative Fee, Franchise Fee and AB393 Fee for this project.

THIS ADDENDUM NO. 1 relates to the above-referenced **VALLEY BOULEVARD AT SANTA ANITA DEMOLITION PROJECT** (hereinafter, the "Project") which will be undertaken by the City of El Monte. This Addendum No. 1 shall be considered part of the bid documents, and provides the following revisions:

1. **APPENDIX 1 (Asbestos-Containing Materials Survey) Page 4 of 7:** The summary of locations and quantities of ACMS for 10611 Valley Mall is revised as follows:

All existing concrete footings and building apparatus below ground surface shall be removed and replaced with compacted fill, unless otherwise noted.

A2: All concrete walkways and curbs immediately adjacent to the buildings, excluding sidewalks on public rights of way, shall be removed as part of the demolition of the buildings. This also includes the concrete slab adjacent to the roll-up doors at 10611 Valley Mall. The planters shall be protected in place. 


