



Live Entertainment Yearly

Any person desiring to conduct a Live Entertainment/Promotional Event shall apply to the Permit Committee for a permit at least thirty (30) days in advance of the date of the proposed Live Entertainment/Promotional Event.

Definition:

Any activity planned, engaged in or permitted to occur for the purpose of or resulting in the pleasing, entertaining, attracting or retaining patrons or customers, and shall specifically include but not be limited to any pact, play burlesque show, revue, pantomime, fashion show, the playing of any musical instrument by any person, and the employment, use or display of nude or semi-nude persons, whether such person engaging in any such activity be owner, proprietor, employee, receptionist, food or bar service worker, dancer, model, customer, patron, amateur or professional performer, or whether hired, retained, displayed, used, permitted to be present, or permitted to participate or engage in any of the activities described in Section 5.12.070 by the owner, permittee, manager or employee of the premises.

Requirements:

1. Supplemental Business Permit Application Forms.
2. Live Entertainment Questionnaire.
3. A plot plan with the stamp of approval from the Planning Department.
4. A letter from the property owner giving applicant permission to use the location.

POLICE DEPARTMENT

4. No after-hours operations. (2:00 a.m. - 6:00 a.m.).
5. Comply with all A.B.C. rules and regulations.
6. No music shall be permitted that is of such volume as to constitute any violation of the City's noise ordinance.
7. Any parking lot connected with the licensed premises shall be regulated by the licensee so that the noise level generated by the permittee's customers or visitors does not constitute a nuisance or an annoyance to any persons residing on any surrounding premises or property.
8. Doors are to be equipped with a self-closing device and are to remain closed during business hours.
50. A licensed security guard firm, approved by the Police Department, may be required to provide security.
851. "No gambling activities of any kind, other than those permitted by State Law shall occur or be conducted within the facility by any person. No devices of any kind, either electronic or non-electronic, shall be allowed within the facility if used for non-permitted gambling purposes.
852. "No electronic or non-electronic device of any kind, or any other thing or object shall be permitted within any area of the facility that is open to or visible by the public or patrons of the business that shows or depicts "specified anatomical areas" and/or "specified sexual activities" as defined in EMMC 5.16.020 of human beings or simulated human beings unless a permit for an adult oriented business has been obtained per Chapter 5.16 of the El Monte Municipal Code."

PLANNING DEPARTMENT

242. Must be operated as a restaurant as defined in Section 17.04.020 of the EMMC.
215. All signs must conform to sign ordinance. Any new signs must have Planning Division approval prior to installation.
230. Portable signs are not permitted.
222. Graffiti must be removed from any exterior surfaces of the structures and improvements on the property within 72 hours following the application of the graffiti.



318. The 50% dining area shall NOT be used AT ANY TIME in connection with the Cabaret Dance/Live Entertainment activities.

704. Event shall comply with the information depicted on the approved plot plan.

CODE ENFORCEMENT

20. Smoking is not permitted inside the facility, pursuant to Labor Code Section 6404.5.

FIRE ENFORCEMENT

963. Must acquire required permits.

LICENSE DEPARTMENT

51. Pursuant to EMMC Section 5.12.260, all other City fees and taxes must be paid in full as a prerequisite to the issuance of the permit. Should the permit holder default on the payment of any fee tax due the City by any provision of law or of this Code, this permit shall become invalid.

BUILDING DEPARTMENT

560. All building electrical plumbing and mechanical elements must be maintained to an acceptable level of code compliance.

561. All exits and exit pathways must be maintained as required by the building codes.
