



ARCADES

Definition

Any building or portion thereof designed, intended and equipped with 5 (five) or more electric or mechanical game machines or combination thereof except that a business with a valid Certificate of Occupancy and business license for another permit use and with no more than 10% of the floor area of said business devoted to arcade machines shall not be classified as an arcade.

Requirements

The applicant must provide a list of property owners (resident/business) within 300 foot radius.

Must be approved by the Planning Department

Procedure

The Permit Committee Secretary needs to notify all such property owners of all Permit Committee hearings not less than 10 (ten) days prior to the hearing date.

Standard Conditions

POLICE DEPARTMENT

297. No arcade shall be established within a 500 foot radius of the outside boundary of any public or private school.
298. No person under the age of 18 years shall be allowed to enter or remain in an arcade, between the hours of 10:00a.m. and 3:00p.m., Monday through Friday, during the regular school year, except on regular school holidays or accompanied by a parent, legal guardian or a duly authorized school representative.
299. No arcade shall be open for business except between the hours of 10:00a.m. and 10:00p.m. on Sunday through Thursday, and between the hours of 10:00a.m. and 12 midnight, on Friday and Saturday.
300. No arcade shall be maintained or operated unless all portions of the interior of such game arcade, except the restroom thereof, are plainly visible from the outside of the building, through unobstructed windows or glass doors.
301. An adult attendant, 21 years of age or older, shall be present at all times in any arcade that is open for business. After 3:00p.m. one attendant for each 15 games or portion thereof or one uniformed security guard.

PLANNING DEPARTMENT

222. Graffiti must be removed from any exterior surfaces of the structures and improvements on the property within 72 hours following the application of the graffiti.

BUILDING DEPARTMENT

560. All building electrical plumbing & mechanical elements must be maintained to an acceptable level of code compliance.
561. All exits and exit pathways must be maintained as required by the building codes.

CODE ENFORCEMENT

20. Smoking is not permitted inside the facility, pursuant to **Labor Code Section 6404.5**.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

532. All exit doors to remain unlocked/unblocked during business hours.
948. Any room having an occupant load of 50 or more where fixed seats are not installed, which is used for assembly purposes, shall have the capacity of the room posted in a conspicuous place on an approved sign near the main exit from the room.

LICENSE DEPARTMENT

51. Pursuant to **EMMC Section 5.12.260**, all other City fees and taxes must be paid in full as a prerequisite to the issuance of this permit. Should the permit holder default on the payment of any fee tax due the City by any provision of law or of this Code, this permit shall become invalid.
