



Mobile Pet Grooming

Requirements

1. A copy of Insurance Policy
(Certificate of Liability)
 - a. Insurance *must not expire* during the term
Of the permit. *(No exceptions)*
 - b. Policy must include an endorsement naming the *City of El Monte, its City Council and its officers, agents and employees as additional insured.*
 - c. Policy must include an Endorsement which provides that *30 days written notice for cancellation of the policy for any reason* will be provided to the City of El Monte.
2. List of all vehicles operating in El Monte (from Insurance Company)
3. Copy of Vehicle Registration for all vehicles operating in El Monte

MOBILE PET GROOMING

Police Department

- 417. Only drivers with a current California driver's license are permitted to operate the vehicle with this permit.
- 861. Operator shall employ *Best Management Practices* (B.M.P) to prevent the discharge of any run-off or pollutants into the public right-of-way. Operator shall comply with all *City National Pollution Discharge Elimination System* (N.P.D.E.S) requirements. No trash, debris, or any waste products shall be left behind after completion of the job.

Planning Department

- 144. No Mobile vendor shall conduct any business within the boundaries of the parking and business improvement area (valley mall)
- 276. Residential property in El Monte shall not be used in any way in connection with a mobile vendor business.
- 964. Graffiti must be removed from vehicle(s) within seventy-two (72) hours following the application of the graffiti.

Licensing Department

- 42. Applicant must provide proof of insurance which meets the standards set forth in the EMMC Section 3.24.160. This insurance must be in effect throughout the term of the permit. Expiration/cancellation of a policy during the term of the permit shall be cause for immediate revocation of the permit.
- 51. Pursuant to EMMC Section 5.12.260 and all other City fees and taxes must be paid in full as a prerequisite to the issuance of this permit should the permit holder default on the payment on any fee or tax due the City by any provision of law or of this code, this permit shall become invalid.

Code Enforcement Department

- 280. "The hours of operation shall be limited to the time period between 9:00 am and sunset for Los Angeles County each day."



Public Works Department

- 890. An automatic shut-off nozzle must be installed on each hose to prevent wasting water.
- 893. No wash products and no degreasing products may be used.
- 894. Protect all catch basins, area drains, trench drains, v-gutters in the area being power washed and its vicinity, to prevent any runoff from reaching the public storm drain system and ultimately the waters of the United States.
- 898. Direct the run off to a pervious area like a lawn or gravel area, or berm the process water and allow it to evaporate, followed by thorough sweeping of the sediments, or vacuum up the process water and properly dispose of it.
