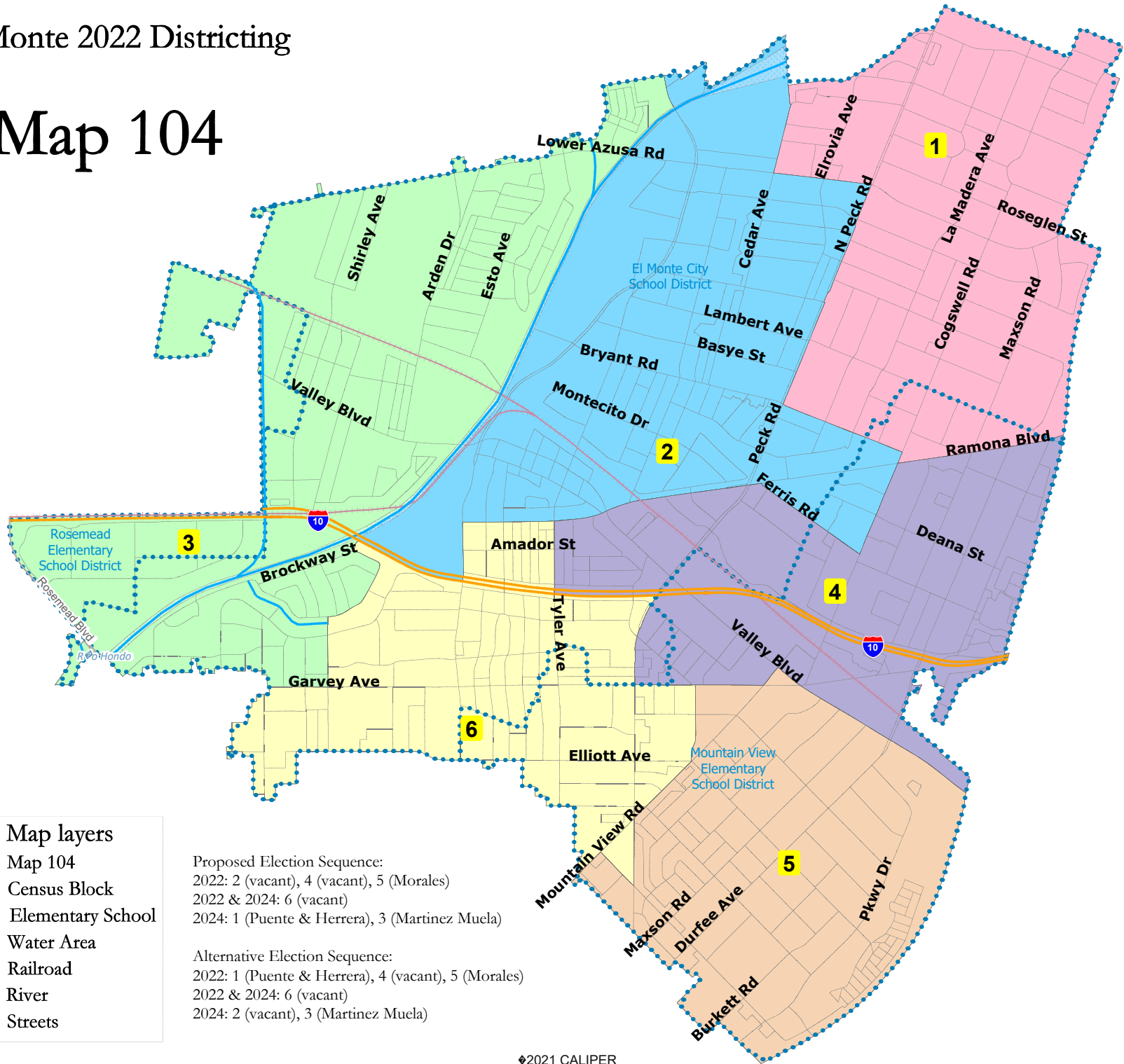


Map 104
